2004-2005 TUITION REMINDER

SUMMER READING 2004

All students at Teurlings are required to read novels for their English classes during the summer. Regular level students are required to read one book while students in honors classes must read two. SUMMER. A magical word – and time – for most students!

Students SHOULD enjoy their summer vacation. Summer is a time to refresh, restore the mind, body, and spirit, and just enjoy life. However, there are limits to any parent's ideas of their child's summer freedom. When you are setting the limits for this summer, try to encourage your child to read, watch the news, and keep their brain functioning over the vacation. If possible, set aside a regular period each day when you expect your son or daughter to read. After all, those summer required reading novels won't get done any other way!

SUMMER READING TESTING

Speaking of summer reading, we are again this year offering students the opportunity to take their tests during vacation. This will allow students to take an additional test for extra credit when school begins, as well as letting them take the test while the novel is still fresh in their memory. Testing will be held on June 23, July 21 and Aug. 4, beginning at 9 a.m. in the school library. Students who want to take advantage of the summer testing should bring a sharpened pencil with them and report to the library before 9 a.m. The tests include mix of matching, multiple choice, and true/false items. More information on the tests can be obtained by checking the Teurlings website at www.tchs.net. A study guide can be found on the website, as well as a complete listing of the books. All books on the list are available at And Books Too, the public library, and other bookstores in town.

SCHEDULES

Schedules will be mailed out to students at the end of June. If you do not receive a schedule by July 19, please call the front office. Schedules will not be changed once school starts and there must be a good reason for any schedule change. Schedules will NOT be changed because students want a different teacher. Also, be aware that in many cases, especially for sophomores, a student's choice of elective class was filled and the second or third choice elective had to be scheduled. In scheduling, seniors are given first priority in elective classes, then juniors, then sophomores. As there were many more requests for Spanish than we could handle, the juniors were given first priority, then names of sophomores requesting Spanish I were drawn from a hat (literally!) for the remaining spots in the Spanish I classes. Many sophomores who requested Spanish I could not be accommodated in the course and adjustments had to be made in those student schedules. If the student requested French I as an alternate choice, the student was placed in French. Please do not ask to be moved to Spanish I, as there is no room. However, any student who was NOT placed in French I who would like to be in the course, may request that we consider a schedule change. Details will be included with the schedule mailed to the student.

TOPS REQUIREMENTS

Students interested in qualifying for a TOPS Award should note that the requirements have changed slightly. Beginning with this year's sophomore class, students must complete 1 ½ credits in computer-related courses to qualify for the award.
