## 2005-2006 Tuition Reminder

The first installment payment is due by July $5^{\text {th }}$ for those parents who selected the 10 month installment finance plan. If you chose the 8 month plan, your first payment is due September $5^{\text {th }}$. Avoid the $\$ 15$ late penalty. If you pay tuition in full by June $23^{\text {rd }}$, you will incur no finance charge. Also, if you choose to have your tuition automatically drafted from your bank account through our direct deposit plan, the form is due to the finance office by June $20^{\mathrm{th}}$.

## IMPORTANT UNIFORM CHANGE FOR 2005-06!

The shoe code for next school year has been changed to the following:

Shoes must be a closed conventional style dress shoe that covers the entire heel. Dress shoes can be brown, navy or black. Tennis shoes are allowed, but must be in one of the following colors: navy, grey, red, black, brown, or white. Heavy Trim must be in one of the above colors. Any other color trim that is on the shoe must be minimal (i.e.: Yellow Nike Swoosh). No boots, sandals, clogs, moccasins, slippers, cleats, are allowed to be worn. Socks must be worn at all times, and shoe laces must betied.

## ACADEMICS

## Marty Heintz - Assistant Principal

As we end one school year and begin preparations for another, it s time to reflect back on some of the academic accomplishments of the 2004-2005 school year:

- Over $\$ 3$ million in scholarships at last count for the class of 2005, continuing our yearly increase not only in dollar amounts, but in the number of students who receive awards.
- Over $60 \%$ of the graduating class qualified and received TOPS awards from the state. As one mother told me, Its like the tuition I paid for him to go to Teurlings pays his college tuition, and I like that! Good philosophy!
■ Five students graduated with perfect 4.0 GPAs AND a minimum of 11 honors courses; there were four other graduates who also had 4.0 GPAs. All nine, Samantha Debevec, Dustin Dought, Jeff Faber, Anna Forester, Camille Gauthier, Amanda LeBlanc, Liz Leday, Chad Songy, and Jason Thibodeaux deserve recognition for never getting that single $B$ to mar their academic record.

68 of our graduates earned a 3.0 GPA or better throughout their high school career. That s over $50 \%$ of the class.

- The TCH Speech and Debate Squad captured another state title and qualified a record number of squad members for the national tournaments which will be held this summer.
- State Literary Rally winner Patrick Allaire kept our string alive, winning the Division II Chemistry prize.
- Approximately one-third of the student body was honored at the annual Academic Pep Rally, with GPAs of 3.0 or better for the first semester.
- The entire student body successfully completed Write Well, Score High, our state grant that provided computers in exchange for participating in a comprehensive writing program.
- Our composite PLAN Test scores for the $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ grade classes continued above both state and national norms and both showed increases from the 2003-2004 school year.
- Madison Montelaro was elected District V Governor for the Louisiana Beta Club.
- Our Teacher of the Year Heath Whittington and Supporter of the Year (and teacher) Linda Doherty were honored by the Diocese of Lafayette.
- Eight teachers were also honored by our faculty and student body as Teachers of the Month.

The list could go on and on. I am extremely proud of our academic accomplishments this year, but more importantly, I am proud of the efforts put forth by our students.

## The final word is READ!

I cannot let the year end without my usual plea to parents for their students during the summer: Please, get your son or daughter to read as much as possible. Reading is the key to higher ACT scores as well as better grades. It doesn $t$ matter what they read, just get them to read!
