#### 2006-2007 Tuition Reminder

The first installment payment is due by July 5<sup>th</sup> for those parents who selected the 10 month installment finance plan. If you chose the 8 month plan, your first payment is due September 5<sup>th</sup>. Avoid the \$15 late penalty. If you pay tuition in full by June 22<sup>nd</sup>, you will incur no finance charge. Also, if you choose to have your tuition automatically drafted from your bank account through our direct deposit plan, the form is due to the finance office by June 19<sup>th</sup>.

#### Summer Reading 2006

All students at Teurlings are required to read novels for their English classes during the summer. Regular level students are required to read one book while students in honors courses are required to read two. # IMPORTANT UNIFORM INFORMATION!

Following our recent annual uniform evaluation, there will be a couple of adjustments and one major change to our uniform policy for the 2006-2007 school year. I have summarized the changes and have also included the details of the uniform policy along

with vendor information. There will be no extra cost involved with these changes or adjustments, but they will bring more consistency in our student uniform.

PANTS (boys and girls): All pants must have a TC logo on the right back hip from one of our vendors. All new pants will have them when purchased and all students with current uniform pants will be able to get a logo put on at no charge at any of our uniform vendors.

GIRLS SHORTS: All girls shorts will also require a TC logo on the bottom left front leg of the short. This logo will tell us that the shorts were measured at the required length when purchased. All new shorts will have them when purchased

and all girls with current uniform shorts of the required length will be able to get a logo put on at no charge at any of our uniform vendors.

**SHOES**: Students will have the option of one style dress shoe or one style tennis shoe which are available at several stores in and around Lafayette, at some of our uniform vendors, online, and at TCH on **July 25**th and **26**th from **9:00am-12:00noon**.






